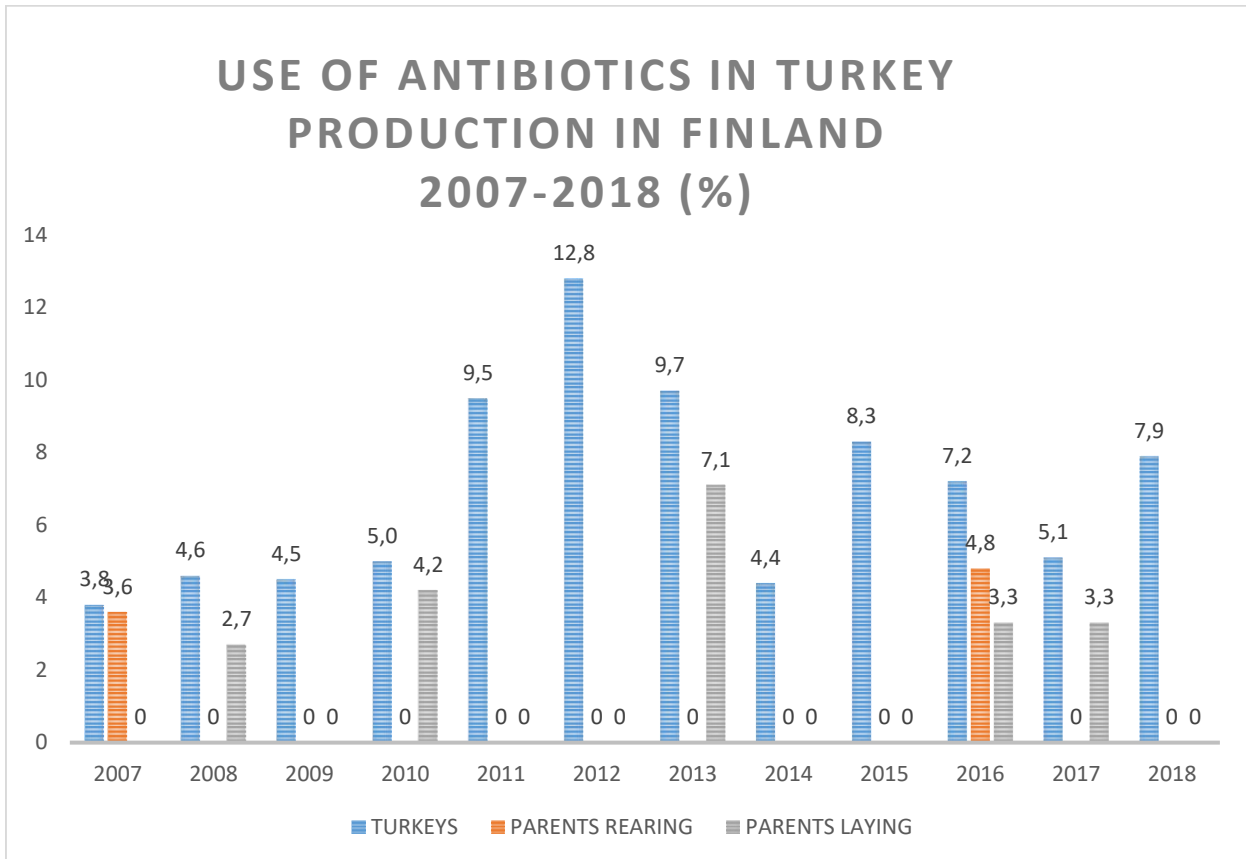

Situation in 2018

- **Broiler flocks**
 - a total of ca. 4010 flocks (2017: 3 850)
 - No antibiotic medication (no antibiotics since 2010)
- **Parent flocks in rearing and laying**
 - a total of 213 flocks (2017: 239)
 - 12 flocks (5,6 %) were medicated with antibiotics (2017: 21), two of them twice
 - Reasons for medication:
 - Tenosynovitis caused by *Staph. aureus* (8 flocks)
 - Necrotic Enteritis and *Pasteurella multocida* infection (2 flocks)
 - Erysipelas (2 flocks)

Included in statistics 2018: > 99,9 % of the broiler production in Finland



Situation in 2018

- **Meat turkey flocks**
 - a total of 303 flocks (2017: 296)
 - 24 flocks medicated with antibiotics (2017: 15)
 - Reasons for medication:
 - Necrotic enteritis (24 flocks)
- **Parent flocks in laying and rearing**
 - a total of 49 flocks (2017: 49)
 - No antibiotic medication (2017: 1)

Included in statistics 2018: ca. 99 % of the turkey production in Finland
